

The East Oakland Youth Development Center Homework Center offers an after school program whose focus is to enhance our children's academic achievement. The Homework Center provides students with a quiet, supportive setting to reinforce skills and complete homework assignments, and offers supervised access to the Center's computer resources. The average daily attendance at the Homework Center is over 35 students!!!

The general purpose of the project is to provide an after-school academic assistance program for students, designed to:

- Assist in the promotion of students who have been identified as being at risk of retention
- Improve student grades and attendance
- Promote safe learning environments in after-school settings
- Allow students to be creative in an academic environment
- Allow students to interact with other cultures
